- 5th - 8th grade students are invited to bike with the Wildwood Crest Commissioners, WCPD and Wildwood Crest Board of Education and Administration to school.
- Preschool - 4th grade students are welcome to ride their bikes to school that day (separate from the bike train).
 - Students participating in the bike train should plan to meet by 7:30am at Ocean and Heather Ave. The entire group will be leaving for school at 7:45am.
 - Riders will travel south and make a right onto Rambler Ave. and then make a left onto Seaview Ave.
 - The caravan will then travel south along Seaview Ave. and then make a right onto Trenton to arrive at Crest Memorial School.

All students must adhere to the WCPD who will direct traffic across the street from Trenton to the school. Once on school grounds, students can walk their bikes to the proper parking location.

- Grades 4th - 8th will park their bikes on the black top. There will be specific locations for each grade.
- Preschool - 3rd will park their bikes next to the doors they normally enter for morning arrival.
** (Gates will be shut and bikes will be monitored throughout the day.)
- All participants of the bike train and ride to school day will be included in a prize-winning raffle sponsored by the PTC. Get your raffle ticket when parking your bike and turn it into your teacher.
- There will be **NO** bike train after school – but the WCPD will be monitoring the streets
